PASSES

Two types of bus passes are color-coded for easy identification.

DISCOUNT PASS (yellow).....20 rides/\$15.00
 DISABLED PERSON (blue).....20 rides/\$10.00

Passes can be purchased at many locations — Call SMTD. DISABLED PERSONS must present a Medicare Card or SMTD ID card when purchasing passes. Students may purchase the DISCOUNT pass at public, parochial, and private schools.

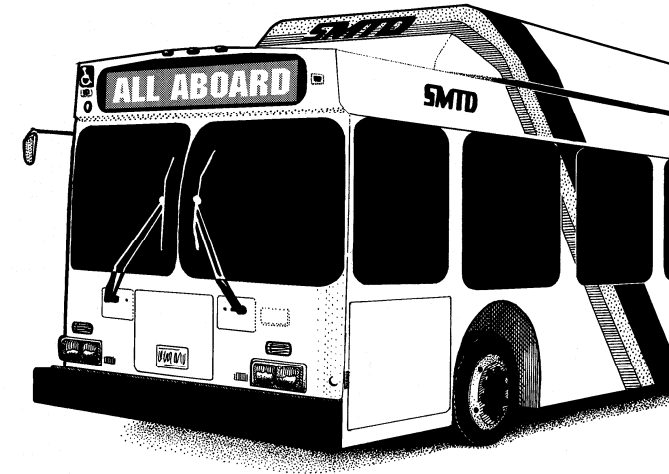

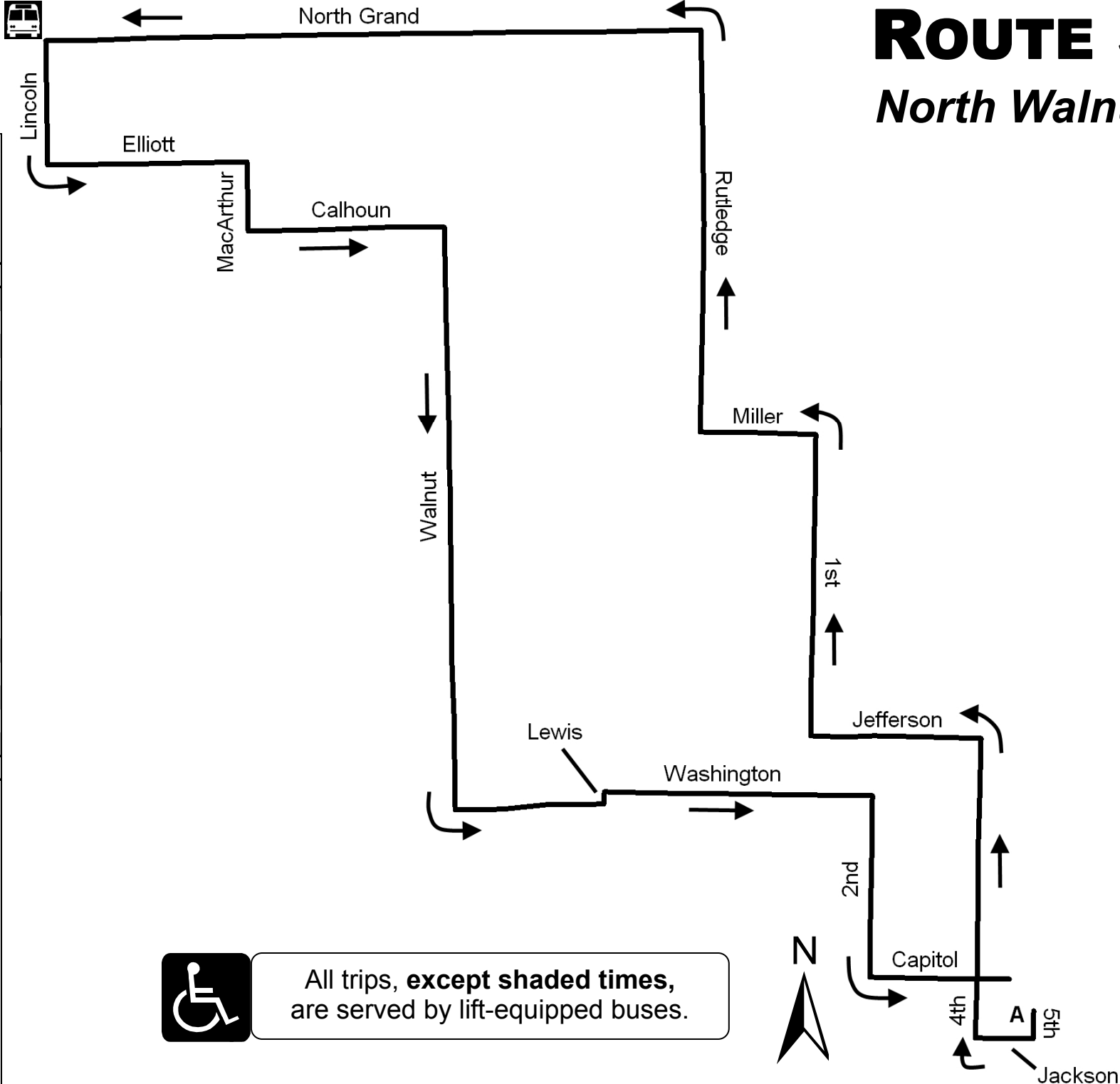
